

# The Guru is available....

*... for brewing classes ... for speaking engagements ... for guided tasting sessions*

Invite the Vermont Home Brew Guru to your group's gathering. I can come to your meeting or party and:

- teach you to brew
- talk about beer and brewing
- lead you through a tasting and appreciation session

For brewing classes, maximum is 8 people; for tasting sessions, maximum is 15 people.  
For speaking engagements, no maximum.

**Brewing classes:** You provide a suitable place to brew, with enough space for your group to gather. Besides the obvious (a stove and good clean water, and space to store your beer while it's fermenting), you should provide as much of the equipment as possible. I can loan or sell you anything you are missing. An extract or partial mash brew will require about 3 hours of time, an all-grain session about 5.

## Equipment required for extract/partial mash brewing:

kettle (4 gallon minimum for extract/partial mash brewing, 6 gallon minimum for all-grain) and long spoon.  
6.5 gallon fermenting bucket w/ lid and airlock  
5 gallon carboy w/airlock  
siphoning equipment  
bottling bucket or equivalent  
50 clean bottles, caps and capper  
hydrometer and thermometer

## Additional for all-grain:

mash tun, sparging apparatus, sparge liquor tank, wort chiller (I can lend these)

I will provide ingredients based on the style and level of expertise. I can also bring some beer for judging, appreciation, evaluation while the brew is happening.

## **Tasting sessions:**

You provide a suitable location where we can legally pour and drink beer. I will provide the beers, glasses, and all necessary extras.

## **Speaking:**

You provide the audience, a microphone (if necessary) and a dais/podium of some kind... I'll provide the knowledge, insight and wit...

## **Fees:**

I get \$40/hour (including travel time) for any of these appearances, plus mileage and the cost of any ingredients, beer, etc.

For example: basic extract brewing class with 3 beers to taste and appreciate, in the Tunbridge/SoRo area:

1 hour travel, 3 hours brewing: \$160  
Ingredients: \$35                      Beer: \$15  
Mileage: 15 miles @ .51/mile = 7.65  
Total: 217.65 - split between 8 people: \$27.21

Each participant would get a six-pack of beer as well as a wealth of knowledge and information, and an unforgettable experience...
